It is possible to display SVG images in WebView using ``, which works all the way back to API 19, but it isn't possible to modify the fill of the SVG file using this method.

Other methods, like `<svg><use href="../../shared_images/add.svg"></use></svg>`, just paint an empty box in WebView.

I think I will wait and see what happens with WebView's new dark mode before proceeding.
